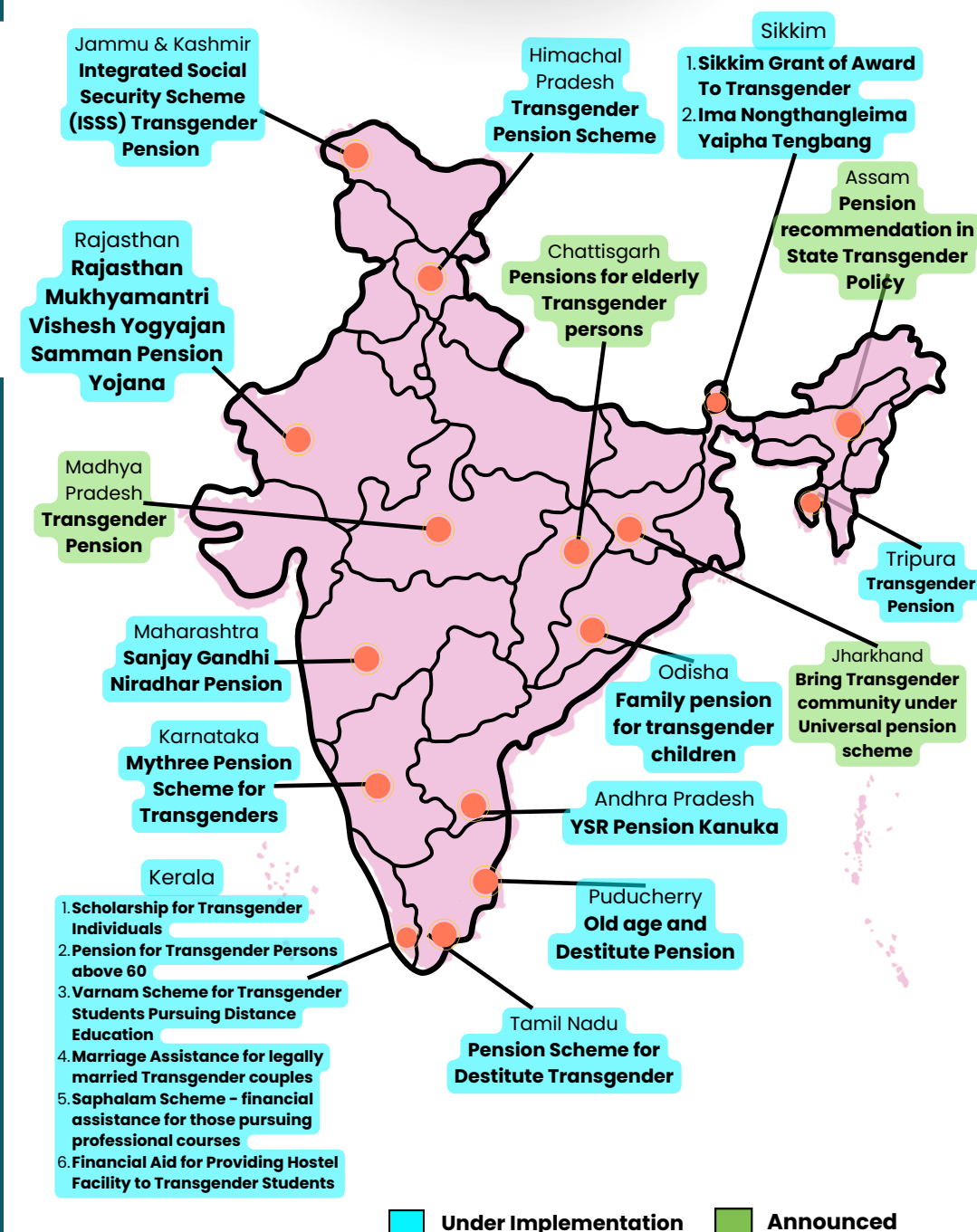
Strength to transition from work to education & vice-versa

CASH-BASED POLICIES IN INDIA FOR TRANSGENDER COMMUNITY



While the above public policies range on the spectrum of conditional cash transfers to closer BI simulations, TG BIC advocates for a Universal Basic Income which is a periodic cash payment unconditionally delivered to all on an individual basis without means-test or work requirement.
